Droitwich Athletics Club welcomes you to the 3rd race in Division 2 of the Midland Womens's Cross Country League 2021-22.

Directions from the North.

Travelling South on the **M5** leave at **Junction 5** and follow the signs for Droitwich. Continue along the A38 passing on the left, the Robin Hood Pub and then the Chateau Impney. At the traffic lights, carry straight on along the dual carriageway. At the large roundabout, (Car Showroom on the left), carry straight on. Take the next exit off the by-pass and take the 1st left at the roundabout in to Ombersley Way. After about half a mile turn left into Briar Mill, over the humps and the Droitwich High School is on the left. (see parking arrangements below)

Directions from the South.

Travelling north on the **M5** leave at **Junction 6**. At island, take the 3rd exit signposted Droitwich. On the left you will pass Worcester Rugby Club. At island take 2nd exit. Straight on to the T-Junction, turn right at the traffic lights. Pass Copcut Elm pub on the left and at the roundabout take the 1st left on to the Droitwich by pass. Take the first exit off the by-pass and at the roundabout take the 4th exit in to Ombersley Way. After about half a mile turn left into Briar Mill, over the humps and the Droitwich High School is on the left.

Parking

Parking this year will be **behind the Droitwich Leisure Centre**. Parking at the school will be restricted to Officials only.

Registration.

Registration will take place in the **Gym at Droitwich High School**. Shower and changing facilities are in the gym.

Course

The course is mainly grass with short stretches of tarmac at bridge crossings. The course is suitable for spikes. The start is located on the Droitwich High School sports field.

The race will commence at 1.30 PM promptly.
