

Bonus Points – comparison to UK 100th ranking from 2022

Within the MCAA T&F League we award five bonus points for performances above a given standard. The table below compares the standard with the 2022 UK 100th rank performance. Apart from a couple of events where the UK 100th rank performance is noticeably lower than the standard, the standard and 100th rank are similar. On average around 14 top-100 ranked athletes are in MCAA T&F league clubs – so having the standard follow the 100-rank value should give equal chance of a bonus point performance across events. The bonus points did though tend to come from the technical events. This is probably not an issue – but simply re-confirms that the league is relatively more popular for higher ranked athletes in the technical event (although total competitor numbers are weaker).
